

Shooting Starz Productions ~ Aladdin Jr., Fall 2019

Registration is open and will close when spots are filled. 24 spots in each cast are open to kids going into grades K-8 (2019-2020 school year). All experience levels welcome!

Cost to participate is \$240 per child. The registration fee covers rehearsal & performance space (including stage rental), script, T-shirt, props, costumes, sets and more. A minimum of \$120 per child (half of the registration fee) must be received with registration form in order for a spot to be held. The remaining amount (\$120 per child) is due on Audition Day. Contact Steph Caron to set up a payment plan if needed.

Minimal undergarments for costumes will need to be provided by the actor themselves due to hygiene (example: tank top, shorts, dark pants or leggings, shoes). Once rehearsals begin, SSP will contact families so they know what specific undergarments they need. Main costumes and costume pieces are provided by SSP.
