

Shooting Starz Productions ~ The Greatest Show, Summer 2019

Registration is open and will close when spots are filled. 45 spots are open for "The Greatest Show". Kids currently in grades K-8 are welcome to register.

Cost to participate is \$240 per child. The registration fee covers practice & performance space rental (including stage rental), script, CD to rehearse with at home, a T-shirt, props, costumes and more. A minimum of \$120 per child (half of the registration fee) must be mailed in with registration form in order for a spot to be held. The remaining amount (\$120 per child) is due on Audition Day. Contact Steph Caron to set up a payment plan if needed.

FAQ's for The Greatest Show

Will there be any spoken parts (lines) in this show?

Yes! This show will have speaking parts in between musical numbers to introduce them and help the show to flow. It will be mainly singing and dancing in this show, however.

Will my child be playing a specific character such as P.T. Barnaum?

No. Cast members will each be in a variety of musical numbers versus playing a specific character.

Which songs from The Greatest Showman will be in this show?

The Greatest Show, A Million Dreams, Come Alive, This Is Me, Rewrite the Stars, Tightrope
Some will feature vocals, others will feature dance, and some songs will feature both vocals and dance. All lyrics used in this show will be family appropriate.

Which praise and worship songs will be in this show?

P & W songs are being determined.

When does my child need to come to rehearsal?

For this show, cast members will only be called to rehearsal when we are working on a musical number that they are in. Auditions will determine which musical numbers they are in, along with conflicts to the rehearsal schedule.

How many casts will there be for this production?

There will be 1 cast for "The Greatest Show". Out of the 45 cast members, there will be between 10-25 kids in each musical number that will make up one big show.

Retreat & Auditions

This evening will feature games, icebreakers and community building for all registered cast members. Short reading, singing & dancing will take place in order to place cast members in the musical numbers best suited for them. **There is nothing that needs to be prepared prior to auditions.** We will rehearse together as a large group each segment of the audition. - Helping your child stick to their commitment to the show. We expect families that sign up for Shooting Starz to help their children make sacrifices when necessary (coming to rehearsal & missing events that that come up after committing to this show)

If your child has more than 3-4 conflicts with the rehearsal schedule it will not work for them to participate. Being a part of a production is a lot of hard work and when working as a team we need actors present whenever possible. **Please be honest with conflicts on the Registration Form.** This will help a lot with casting.
