****Please note the theater is in the lower level of the Ramada by Wyndham Plymouth-** we will email out what you should be looking for. You may park in the hotel parking lot and go to the hotel registration entrance. The playhouse is to the right and down the stairs.

Tech Rehearsal at Plymouth Playhouse

Thurs. April 16th 5:00-8:30 PM

Actors should bring all of their costumes, script to follow along with backstage and a water bottle in a labeled bag or container. Kids may bring a snack for a short snack break. Please bring something that is not crumbly or messy please. *We do not allow parents to watch during the tech rehearsal. There are limited areas inside to stay and wait. If you are volunteering backstage or with lights/sound, you will need to attend the tech rehearsal to practice what you will be doing during performances.*

Costumes- For those changing costumes during the show, we strongly suggest underclothes- such as a tank top and shorts. There are limited private bathrooms backstage and some kids have quick changes.

Performances at Plymouth Playhouse (address above), estimated 90 min. in length including a short intermission

Cast members should arrive at the call times below. **Cast members should come with their hair styled (something to match their character/out of their face) and make up completed. Make up is optional- lipstick, mascara, etc.**

Please have your child rest and eat before they arrive for each performance. Food is not allowed backstage during performances- only water.

Sun. April 19th Call time 4:15 PM, Performance 5:00 PM

Thurs. April 23rd Call time 5:45 PM, Performance 6:30 PM

Sun. April 26th Call time 4:00 PM, Performance 4:45 PM followed by recognition of each actor. Right after bows, staff call up each actor individually to say special things about them.

Seating: Seating for everyone begins 20 minutes prior to show start time. Ushers will help everyone find their assigned seats.
