

Shooting Starz Productions ~ Shrek Jr. 2025

Shrek Jr. is a 60 minute musical. All registered actors receive a role that has individual speaking and/or singing parts with lots of stage time! There are no ensemble roles in our productions.

Registration opens on Fri. Sept. 27th at 7:00 PM. Registration is taken on a first come first serve basis. Waitlists are started once all casts have been filled.

Shooting Starz Productions is a Christian theatre company. We encourage growth in confidence and self-esteem in a humble way. We pray before each rehearsal and performance. We believe that Jesus has given each actor the talents they exhibit. We welcome families of all belief types to participate in our programs. Encouragement used during rehearsals may come from Bible verses from the Old or New Testament or the fruits of the Holy Spirit.

There are currently 2 casts being offered. Shrek Jr. has multiple unique characters, so we are increasing our cast size to approximately 30 for this show. Our rehearsals will have multiple break out groups and additional staff so the kids will still have a small cast feel. We are also adding an additional performance

compared to previous years!

Our 4-12th grade cast will be more challenging due to the older age group. All casts have a director that has personal performing experience in addition to directing experience. All casts will also have a vocalist to work with.

Registration fee is \$250 per actor/actress. The registration fee covers rehearsal & performance space, show licensing, script, T-shirt, props, sets and more. Actors provide their own costumes. Costumes can be put together inexpensively. We provide a costume suggestion list to help. **Registration fees are non refundable.**

A minimum of \$125 is due to hold your child's spot. The remaining \$125 is due on Audition Day. If you are currently involved in Frozen Jr., a minimum of \$50 is due to hold your child's spot. Please contact Steph if you are in need of a payment plan. shootingstarzprod@gmail.com
In the event that a check bounces, the party writing the check will need to submit an alternative form of payment for the registration fee as well as fees charged to Shooting Starz for the bounced check.

Commitment: Actors may have ONE CONFLICT with a regular rehearsal. Tech rehearsal and performances are mandatory. If your child cannot make the Retreat/Audition Day, please contact Steph prior to registering. Conflicts or potential conflicts need to be shared, prior to Audition Day.

Being a part of a theatre production is a lot of work. With small cast sizes and no understudies, we need every actor/actress to put on the show. We ask that parents help their child to rehearse at home to memorize their lines and song lyrics and learn their choreography. Videos will be shared that can be used to rehearse at home. For rehearsals that are missed, cast members are expected to connect with their director to find out what they should rehearse to be prepared for the next rehearsal.

Other things to note:

- Cast members are asked to bring their script and a filled water bottle to rehearsal. No food or snacks please.
- Shooting Starz auditions, rehearsals including tech rehearsal and teambuilding days are closed to parents (other than volunteers) and non-registered children.

- Prayer is included at most of our events. Cast members are always invited to join. Prayer is optional.
- All performances have ticketed audiences.
- Videos and photos of cast members are posted on our Facebook, Instagram and Youtube pages. No names are included.
- Volunteers are needed in many arenas- rehearsal volunteers, backstage volunteers, building sets and props, taking headshot photos, sound and light volunteers, help during performances and more!

Audition Day- Specific audition information will be sent out to registered families the month before auditions. We make auditions as welcoming as possible, especially for our young actors. Auditions help us to place the registered cast members into roles. We also take time to play some icebreaker games during this time as well!

We also offer a Teambuilding Day for each of our casts mid season. It is a great opportunity to continue building friendships in a fun way through games and other activities.

Registered actors and actresses will receive information regarding our Meet'N'Greet event! This will tentatively take place on Sun. December 8th at 1:30 PM. There will be paperwork for parents to fill out as well as fun ways for cast members to connect with one another and ask questions.
